NAZARENE YOUTH CONFERENCE <u>JULY 10-14, 2019</u> PHOENIX, ARIZONA



Hosted by the Church of the Nazarene USA/Canada Region, NYC is a powerful youth event that has been held in different locations over the past six decades. NYC takes place every

four years and provides an opportunity for high school students from the USA and Canada to be united in a time of worship, teaching, and community service. This year's theme is 'Love God, Love Others'. Registration is closed and we have 8100 participants from North America, including 184 Canadians, registered for this year's conference. This event has been life changing to so many young people – young people that are shaping our Church of the Nazarene landscape today.

NAZARENE COMPASSIONATE MINISTRIES CANADA (N.C.M.C.) UPDATES

Update on Cyclone Idai Disaster Response

Hundreds of thousands of victims of Cyclone Idai who were displaced by severe flooding are beginning to recover their homes and livelihoods in Mozambique, Malawi, and Zimbabwe. Many have lost family and friends and have seen their homes and crops (sources of food) devastated. As the water levels remained high for some time, cases of cholera, malaria, diarrhea, and respiratory infections were prevalent due to poor living conditions in crowded shelters and camps.

NCM International provided initial relief supplies in all three countries, including food for displaced families in Mozambique, Malawi and Zimbabwe.

Shipping containers (10' x 40') filled with dried food donated by Gleaners was shipped by Compassionate Resource Warehouse in partnership with NCM Canada to Malawi and Mozambique. The containers have just arrived and the contents are being distributed.

A full ration of food provided by NCM Canada through Canadian Foodgrains Bank, is be-

ing distributed to the most affected victims living along the Shire river in Southern Malawi. Maize flour, beans, and cooking oil make up the ration for 1000 families. Additional supplementary food (corn-soy blend) is being provided to pregnant and nursing mothers, and children under 5.

Thank you for giving to this relief effort! The funds for food through CFGB are matched 4:1 by the Canadian government. Lives are being saved and people without help or hope are able to begin to recover and rebuild their lives! You are making a difference!


