Within the past two weeks, there have been Facebook pages circulating with links to damaging news articles about Bangladesh Nazarene Mission. This has prompted NCM Canada to release to you this update on the status of the investigation in Bangladesh.

If you should receive questions which cannot be answered by the attached statement, please direct them to me, copied to Dr. Clair MacMillan.

Dr. Clair MacMillan has received and approved this statement, and is sharing this information with Canadian District Superintendents (Church of the Nazarene Canada).

We urge you not to forward, share, retweet, or pass on in any way, any gossip concerning Bangladesh and/or Bangladesh leaders that is appearing in social media and elsewhere. We ask that if you learn of others posting, sharing, or re–tweeting such articles, that you urge them to refrain from doing so.

CANADA 150 PRAYER PROJECT

In 2017 Canada, our country, will be 150 years old. To commemorate this birthday many Canadians will do 'special' things, visit other parts of the country or create something special.

Recently the thought came to me to pray for 150 Canadian cities, towns, places or people groupings in our land, one for each year of confederation. So I'm planning to do that. (I hope I can do it). Then I thought it would be good if more Canadians would pray for various places or peoples in our country. Perhaps you would also like to take this on as a prayer project?

God has given us such a beautiful, rich and varied land with a people that by and large are hard—working, polite, and basically honest in their dealings with other people. We are all blessed. To be able to finish praying for all 150 items one would need to pray for about 12–15 in one month. Praying for more in a month would reduce the length of time needed.

I'm adding a 'prayer guide' with the specific 'items' for prayer on it in the blog. It will be updated monthly giving prayer items for the next month (or months). It may also contain some impressions or thoughts that people had, etc. You can also forward any comments or thoughts you may have. Feel free to pass this idea on to others, use in your church or group, or make copies of the prayer list, etc.

(James 5:16 NIV) If you're a follower of Jesus Christ this would be you. Our country needs God, His grace, His forgiveness, His ways.
